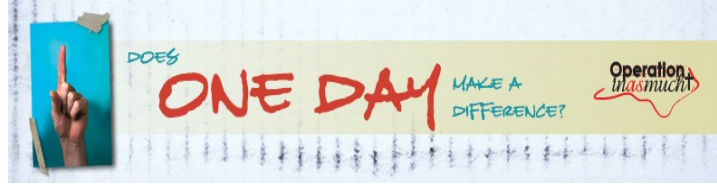

From the Director of Missions...

New Member Church. We welcome Word Tabernacle Church in Rocky Mount as a new member church admitted to the association as of the last Executive Board meeting on May 20, 2010. The church began as a new church start almost five years ago. It meets in the old Calvary Church location on Nashville Road. The primarily African-American congregation has 1600 people attending Sunday worship services. The church has a ministry philosophy that reaches out to the local community and ministers to people by meeting practical needs in the process of sharing Christ. Word Tabernacle is already part of the SBC and the Baptist State Convention. The founding pastor, Rev. James Gailliard, is a very effective Bible teacher and leader. He is originally from Philadelphia, where he helped establish 26 new congregations while serving as a church planter and ministry coordinator for the North American Mission Board.



Greater Joy Church Plant Update

The financial support that Greater Joy has received from First Baptist, RM, Elm Grove, NRBA, and the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina has been used to help the church establish new ministries to reach out to the community. The church is making hundreds of ministry contacts each month; baptized over 100 people since it was established; and now have over 500 in combined attendance for two Sunday morning worship services. Our goal in supporting Greater Joy is not to help them survive but to help establish a church with a strong outreach ministry that will impact the community. Rev. Shelton Daniel and Greater Joy is already a great ministry partner for our association. The Association Executive Board has approved an increase in financial support from \$250 to \$500 per month till association funding is completed in Sept.



New Ministry Programs have included: Children's Summer Day Camp and After-School ministry, Technology Camp for Teens, *Fathers and Families* Program, Men's Ministry Mentoring Program for boys, Bi-weekly Food Bank Distribution ministering to over 600 families, Community Prayer Walking, Women's Conference, Neighborhood Block Parties, Community Health Fair, Adult Praise Dance Team, Intercessory Prayer ministry, "Sow Where You Want to Grow" evangelism program.

Grace International Fellowship is making ministry contacts every month. Four small group Bible Studies meet in various locations throughout the week. Many people have made public professions of faith and thus far 7 people have been baptized following discipleship training. Special programs and events have had as many as 60 in attendance and 25-30 meet weekly for worship Sunday afternoon. New ministries include a Children's Sunday School Class, Leadership Training, Friday Night Basketball Fellowship, and Special Evangelistic Concerts. Hear Pastor Delfin Orendain's passion for ministry in the following ministry report excerpts:



"I was able to make contact to some Filipinas (who are married to Americans) who are residing in Rocky Mount but never had the opportunity to hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus. Thus, after they heard the presentation of the Gospel in one of our Bible studies, they made a profession of faith to our Lord Jesus Christ! Praise the Lord!"

"... in one of our Bible Studies at a Chinese Restaurant, I met 4 more contacts who are actually looking for a Filipino Christian Church for the past 3 months."

[During an evangelistic Thanksgiving Day Fellowship Luncheon] *"we invited relatives and friends of church members. ... After everyone had given their testimonies, I gave a 10 [minute] sharing of God's Word and gave an invitation to the group if anyone would like to commit or surrender their lives to the Lord Jesus. 8 people made professions of faith!"*

We are so thankful for Northside Community, Red Oak, Proctor's Chapel, Calvary, RM, Nashville, and Salem Churches for joining with our association and the Baptist State Convention to make this ministry possible.

Greater Joy Missionary Baptist and Grace International Christian Fellowship have been received into 'Watch Care' under a Mission Church status. You can be a part of this ministry by praying for these church plants in our association.

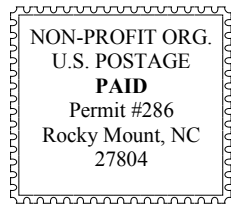
NRBA Pastors (ON TOUR...in Brooklyn, NY!)
