- 7. Contact missionaries** and local ministers for missions programs and pulpit supply.
- 8. Get free samples of Lifeway Sunday School Literature** twice a year at the association office. Determine which materials are best to meet the needs of your church.
- 9. Receive fast, customized demographic studies** of your local community to help determine community needs and ministry strategies for your church at the association office.
- 10. Maintain personal contact with missionaries** around the world; learn about their day-to-day activities; and pray for specific current needs through the association website.
- 11. Plan Missions Discovery Trips, Prayer Walking Opportunities, and One Day Mission Trips** to the International Mission Board, Baptist Children's Homes, etc. Your DOM is familiar with every ministry and will be happy to help make arrangements for your trip.
- 12. Let the association help provide financial support for your first Disaster Relief Trip.**
- 13. Ask your Director of Missions to speak** during your WMU, Brotherhood, R.A., G.A., etc. meeting or have your missions meeting at the association office. A complete kitchen with cookware, china and seating for 50 is available to you for missions promotion.
- 14. Link onto many outstanding ministry websites** to find practical information for church families through [www.northroanokebaptistassociation.org](http://www.northroanokebaptistassociation.org) such as Crown Financial Ministries, one of our association ministry partners.
- 15. Refer counselees** to Dr. Mike Garrett, an outstanding Surecord Counselor at the association office. He is a licensed, Christian Counselor with over 25 years of experience.
- 16. Learn about special ministry events,** revivals, youth activities, conferences, etc. that are taking place at other association churches. The smallest congregation can have an outstanding ministry by attending these events. You are always welcome.
- 17. Remember** that every church can more effectively fulfill the Great Commission as we work together. Your church is sharing the Good News of the Gospel, impacting lives, strengthening existing churches, and planting new congregations through the ministry of your association.
